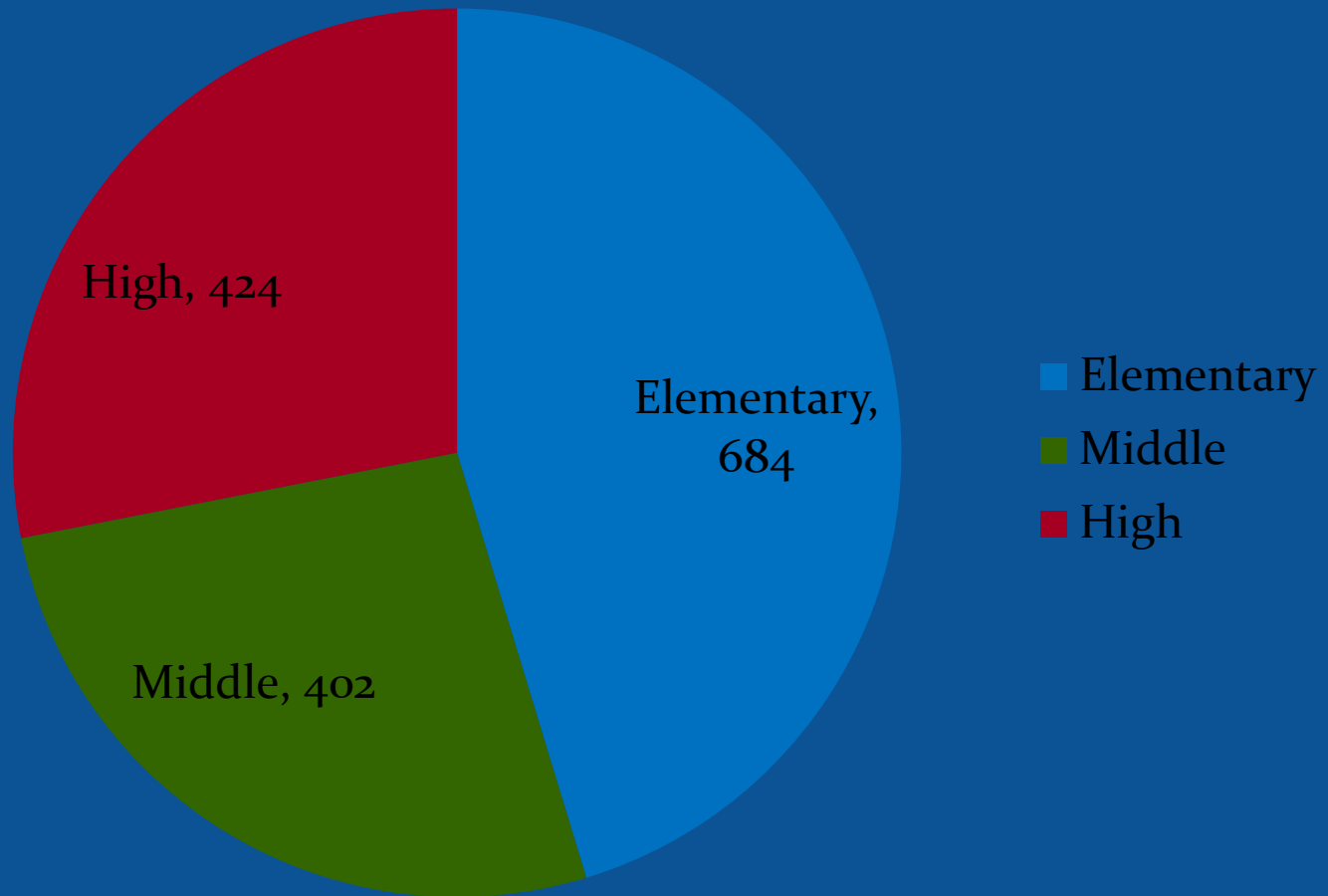

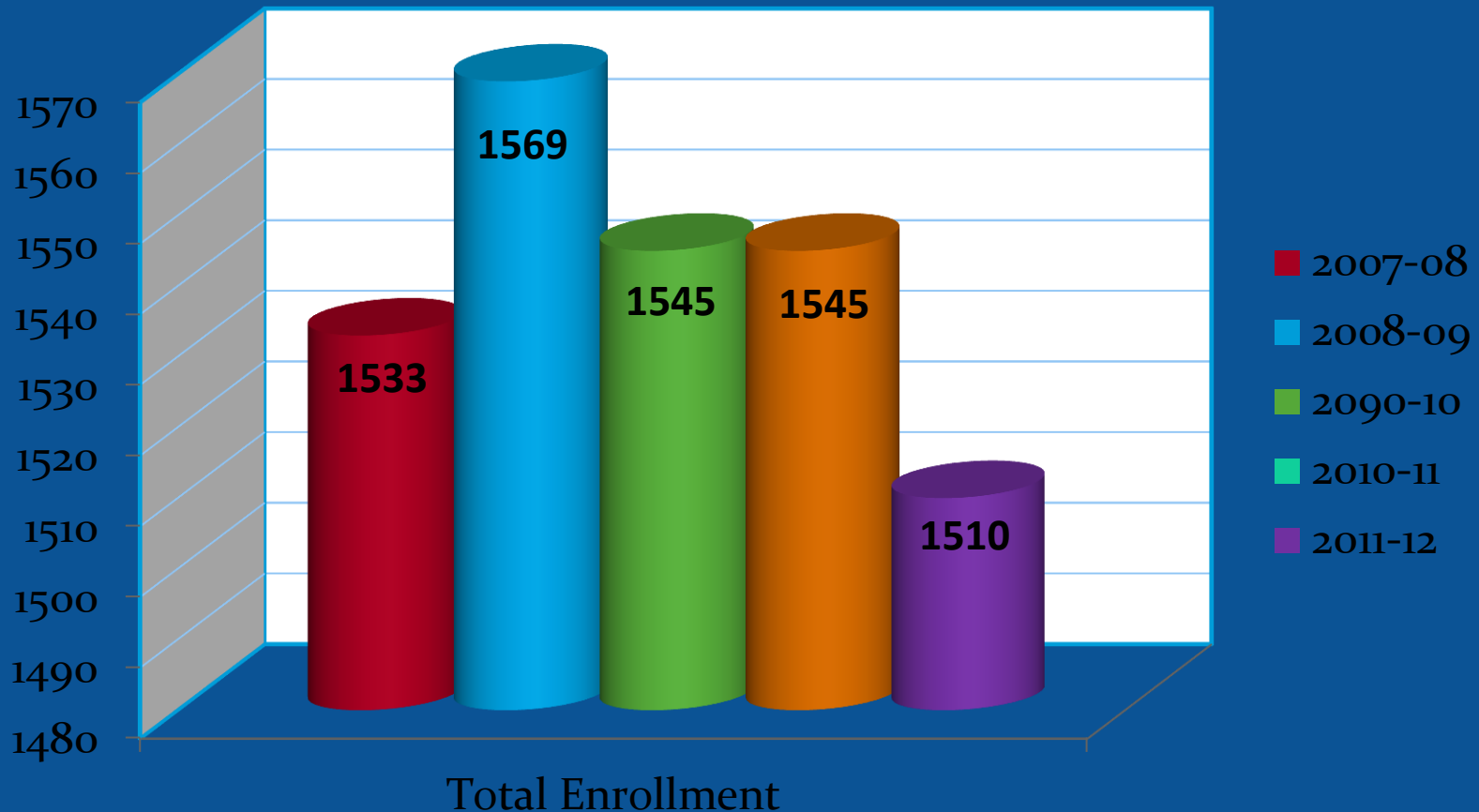

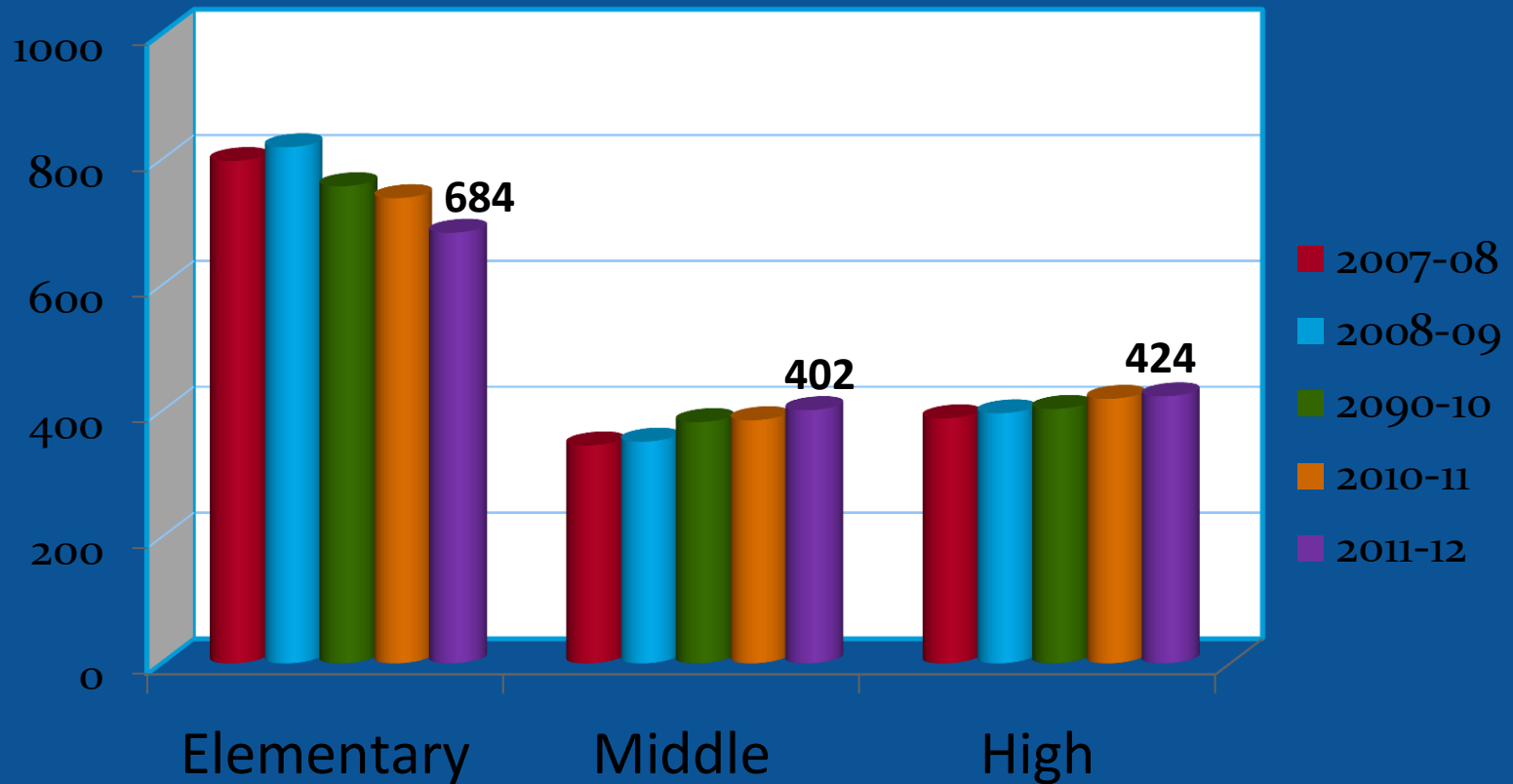
Enrollment 2011-2012



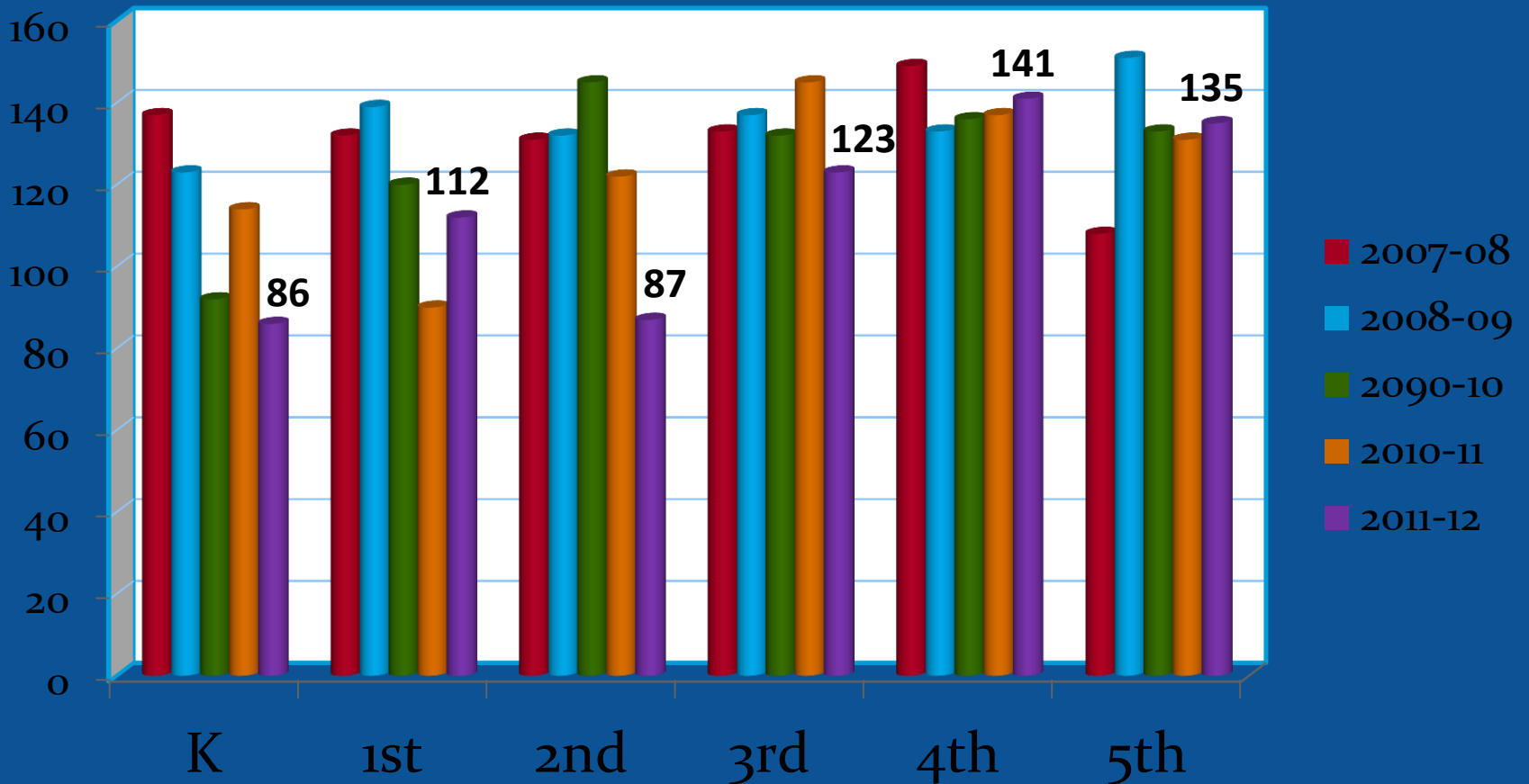
Total District Enrollment



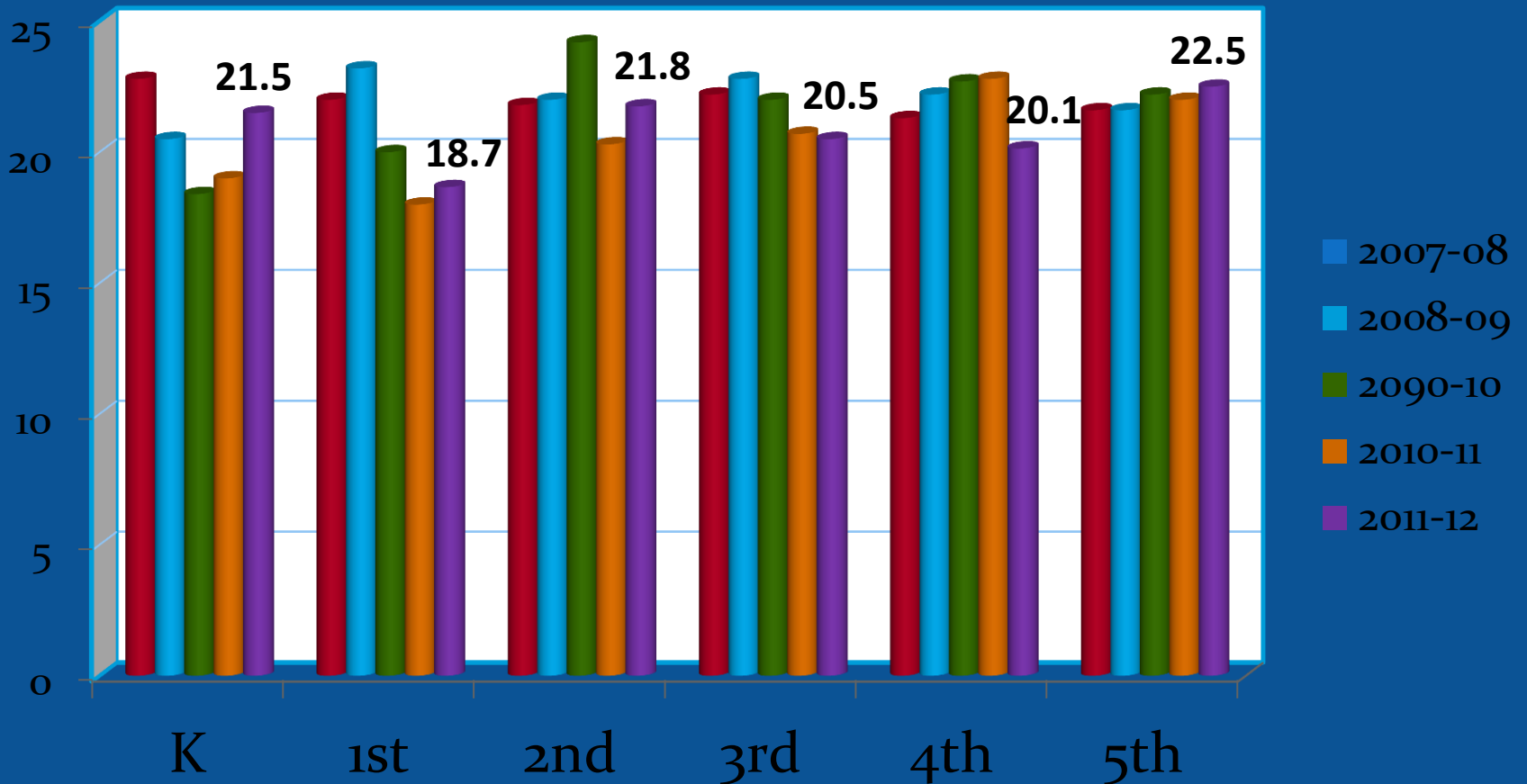
Total School Enrollment



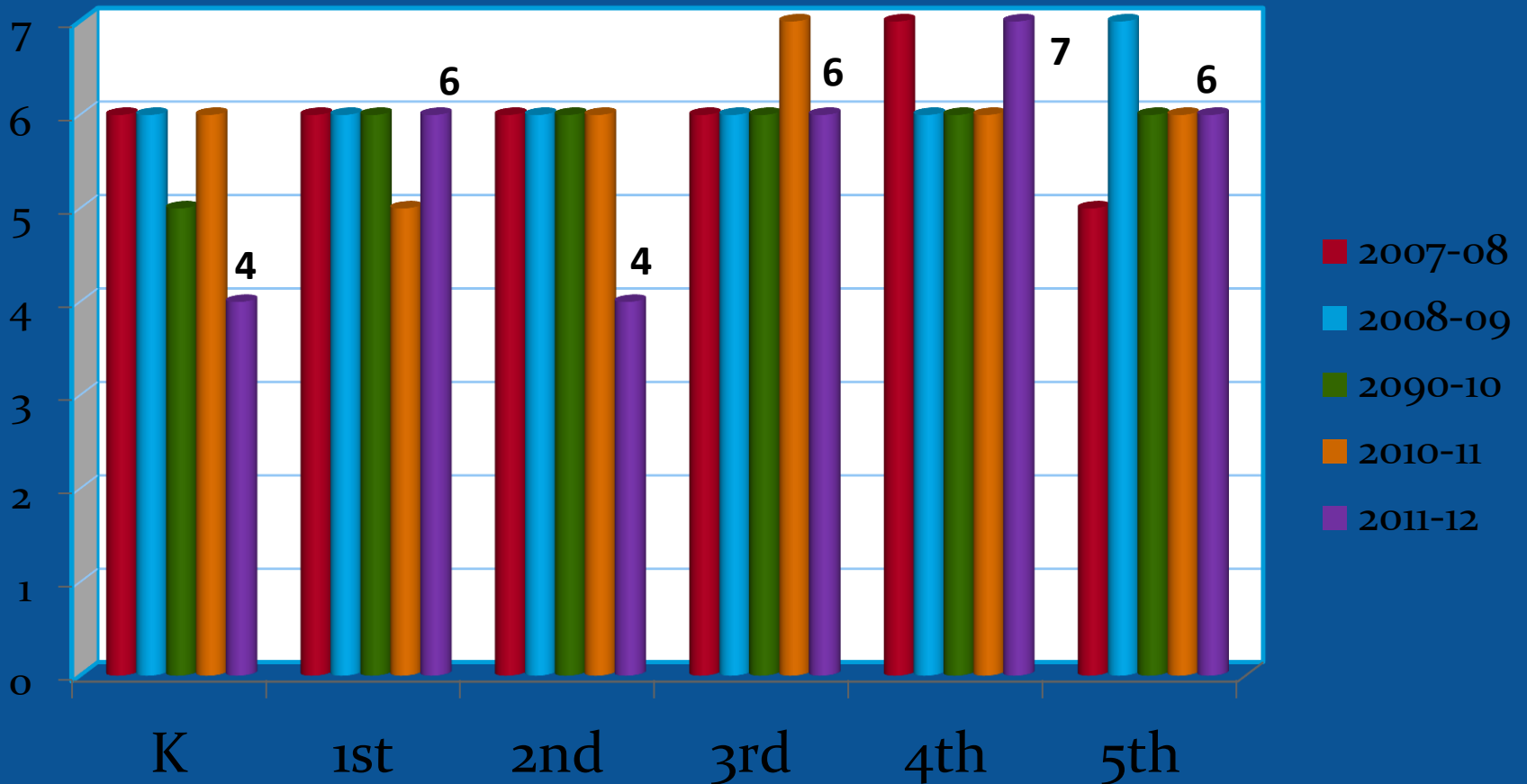
Bruno M. Ponterio Enrollment



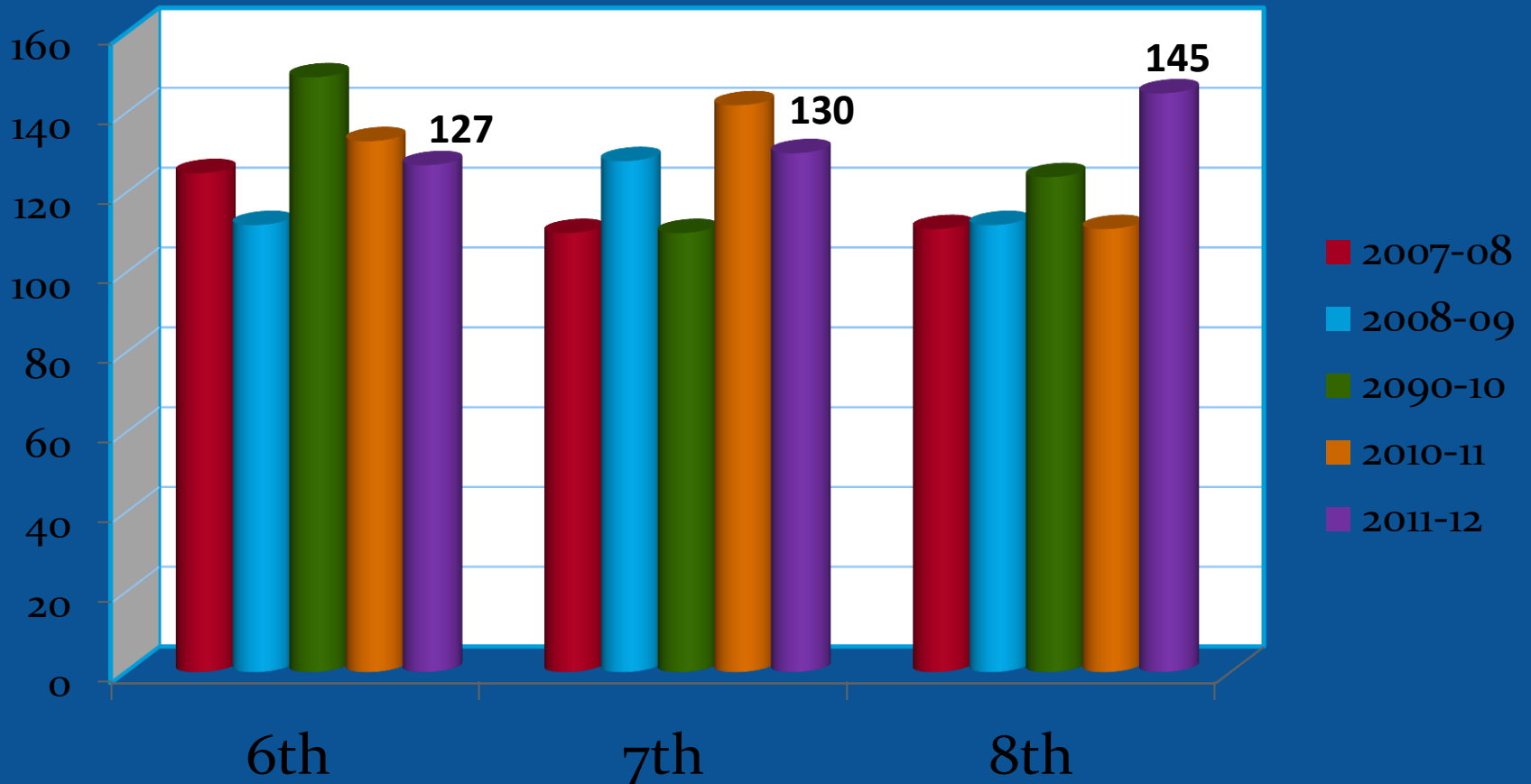
BMPRSS Average Class Size



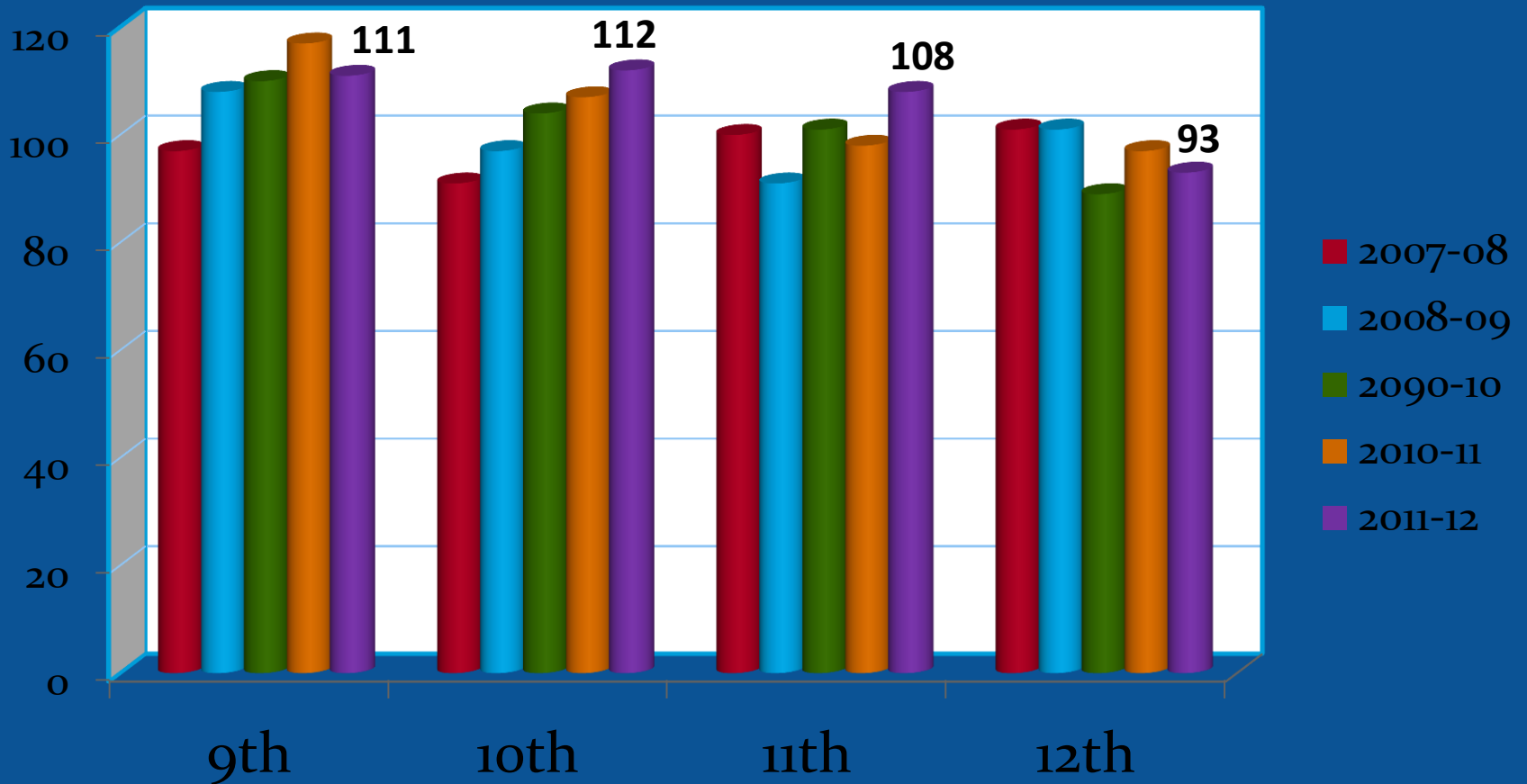
BMPRSS Sections by Grade

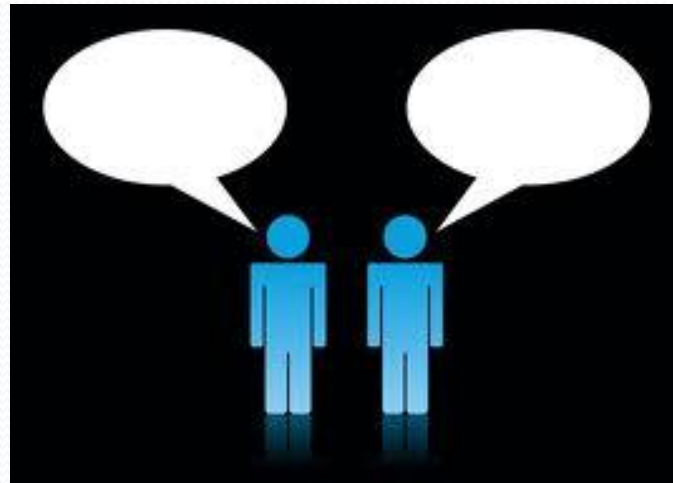
