This week was my first week back since having my baby. I am very excited to be with the students again. Señorita Ribuffo did a fantastic job keeping the students up to date and learning ESPAÑOL!

This week in kindergarten we have been getting to know each other. We have been having fun singing songs and playing games, all while learning to express ourselves in a new language!

We are practicing the colors in Spanish and learning how to express what color something is in Spanish. Señorita Ribuffo taught the children a beautiful song called Rojo, Café. **For a fun activity, ask your child to sing it for you while pointing to the colors in the song.**

The Kindergarten students made spiders with Mrs. Murphy in art class and in Spanish they are learning to sing The Itsy Bitsy Spider ~ La Araña Pequeñita.

In first grade, we are also practicing the colors in Spanish. We are reintroducing ourselves and for some students meeting for the first time.

We are going to be coloring SOMBREROS (hats) for the skeletons that they are making in Art class. Art and Spanish are coordinating for a lesson about Día de los Muertos (Day of the Dead). We will be reading a book about Día de los Muertos in Spanish class.

First grade students went to the Maritime Aquarium. We will be talking about the animals that they saw – in Spanish!

In second grade, we are reviewing colors. We are introducing ourselves and learning how to introduce a friend in Spanish.
