In Kindergarten we have been learning about shapes. We have been searching in our classrooms for circles, squares, triangles, and rectangles in the objects that we see everyday.

We put the parts of the snowman on a snowman. In Spanish we say, muñeco de nieve or hombre de nieve. We are singing a fun song called Mi hombre de nieve. It is to the tune of Frosty the Snowman. We are talking about the season of winter and some of the clothing that we wear in winter.

Los elefantes are hanging up on the bulletin board outside the Spanish classroom and they look great! The children love singing Los elefantes.

Very soon we will be learning about apples and the famous artist Cézanne. Spanish and art are connecting again! How fun!

In first grade, we are learning about the clothes that we wear in winter. The students from Mrs. Esposito's class made labels for the winter clothing in Spanish to go with the labels that they wrote in English.

We are reviewing the shapes that we learned last year and learning some new shapes. We are going to be making Muñecos de Nieve (snowmen) using different geometric shapes.

In second grade, we are also learning about winter, what clothes do we wear in winter, what activities do we do in winter.

The students now know how to say the months of the year in Spanish. Soon, we will be talking about birthdays and how we celebrate our birthdays.
