Kindergarten - Second Grade

In Kindergarten, we have been talking about apples and we are asking the question, "¿Qué manzana prefieres tú? (What kind of apple do you prefer? **La manzana roja, verde o amarilla** (red apple, green apple or yellow apple). So far, la manzana roja seems to be the most popular. We are going to continue learning about different kinds of fruits.

In first grade, the students are finishing up their winter clothing designs and will be doing dialogues with each other about the winter clothing that they are wearing. We are going to be learning about the school supplies that we need and use everyday ~ ¿Qué hay en la clase? / ¿Qué hay en la mochila? (What's in the classroom? / What's in my backpack? We are also going to be talking a little about the importance of punctuation and the differences between English and Spanish.

In second grade, we are doing something very exciting! We are doing a Technology/ Spanish project with Mrs. Asencio and Mrs. Vallarelli. The students are going to make a class **Libro Abecedario** (alphabet book) using Powerpoint. We have been learning about the Spanish alphabet, learning to read in Spanish, practicing the vowel sounds, etc. The students will now have an opportunity to create class books showing off what they are learning in computer class and español. The students will also be able to hear how they sound speaking Spanish because they are going to record their voices ~ pronouncing the letter in Spanish and the words.
