If the weather cooperates, we will have our first evacuation drill of the year this afternoon. The purpose of these drills is to practice how we would safely leave the building in the event of a fire or other emergency. Mr. Dakers recently came across an interesting fact - on September 11, 2001, an estimated 13,000 people were successfully able to evacuate from the World Trade Center. During these drills students are expected to remain silent so that you can hear any directions that may be given. Teachers are asked to notify the main office with the names of any students who are not behaving appropriately during the drill.

## **DURING FLEX TODAY:**

**8th Grade:** You have your first Advisory meeting today during FLEX. Please check FlexTime Manager for your assigned location.

**7th Grade:** You will begin using FlexTime Manager today. Each morning, students should log onto FlexTime Manager to see if you have been assigned to a location or if there are choices available to you. If you are not assigned, you must choose where you want to go for the first  $\frac{1}{2}$  and second  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the FLEX block. Once you make choices, they can be changed up until 20 minutes before FLEX block begins. Right before FLEX starts, students should go back onto FlexTime Manager to see if you are still going to where you chose or if a teacher has assigned you somewhere else.

**6th Grade:** Will start using FlexTime Manager later this week. For today, please follow your teachers' directions for the FLEX block.

We have been asked to remind students of the District Dress Code. Specifically:

- Garments that expose excessive skin are not appropriate. This includes tube tops, halter tops, plunging necklines (front and/or back), short shirts (crop tops), short skirts/shorts and see-through garments are not appropriate.
- Underwear (including bras) must be completely covered with outer clothing.
