FLEX Block Reminders:

- Each morning, students should log onto FlexTime Manager to see if you have been assigned to a location or if there are choices available to you. If you are not assigned, you must choose where you want to go.
- You must choose a location for the first half of Flex (called Flex 1) and the second half of Flex (c ½ and second ½ of the FLEX block. Once you make choices, they can be changed up until 20 minutes before FLEX block begins. Right before FLEX starts, students should go back onto FlexTime Manager to see if you are still going to where you chose or if a teacher has assigned you somewhere else.
